

INFORMATION NOTICE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA OF PARTICIPANTS IN THE "SUONI LIBERI" PROJECT PURSUANT TO EU REGULATION 2016/679

Regarding the processing of personal data provided for registration/selection/participation in the "Suoni Liberi" project, pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679, please be informed that:

1. Data Controller and Data Protection Officer (DPO)

The Data Controller is Opera Universitaria, with registered office in Trento, via della Malpensada, 82/A - email operauniversitaria@pec.operauni.tn.it (hereinafter briefly referred to as "Opera" or "Controller"). The contact details of the Data Protection Officer (DPO) appointed by Opera are: dpo@operauni.tn.it.

2. Types of Data Processed, Purposes, and Legal Basis of Processing

The following personal data relating to project participants are collected and processed: a) Common personal data (name, surname, personal details, contact information, phone number, email) b) Data related to the group's performance and artistic/professional characteristics (e.g., group biography, performance videos, lyrics of performances) c) Photographs, images, video recordings, stage photos, group name, and any other biographical information/news of the participants.

The data mentioned above are collected and processed for the following purposes: registration, selection, and participation in the project; maintenance of internal documentation of Opera's cultural events; dissemination of the event through Opera's channels.

The legal basis for the processing of data for the aforementioned purposes is therefore: the fulfillment of contractual obligations for participation in the project and the legitimate interest of the Controller for the purposes of disseminating the event through Opera's channels and for artistic archiving of the material.

3. Disclosure of Data to Third Parties - Data Recipients

Opera may disclose the processed data for the execution of the aforementioned purposes to internal and external parties collaborating in the management of the project and to the company that manages the website related to registrations. Images and videos may be disseminated through Opera's website and social media channels.

4. Transfer of Data to Third Countries

Data is not directly transferred by the Controller to Third Countries. However, in case of any data transfer to Third Countries, the transfer will take place in compliance with the relevant data transfer regulations in force from time to time (Articles 44 et seq. of Regulation 2016/679).

5. Processing Methods, Retention Period, and Data Retention Criteria

Data will be processed in paper and digital format in compliance with current regulations. The data will be processed by the Controller for the period necessary for the execution of the purpose(s) indicated above and, at their conclusion, for the further period related to educational, archiving, artistic interest, and public information purposes.

6. Provision of Data

The provision of data is mandatory for the selection/registration/participation in the project and the execution of the indicated purposes. Failure to provide the data therefore prevents the execution of said purposes.

By participating in the project, contestants acknowledge and authorize the processing of their personal data, both in paper and electronic form, by Opera for the purposes of project participation and dissemination.

By participating in the project, contestants provide express, free-of-charge authorization for Opera and the third-party entities involved to use the materials as an archive and for promotional initiatives of the event, the recording and broadcasting or dissemination in various forms, including social media channels, web, and web radio, or other materials derived from the process, on a gratuitous basis.

7. Data Subject Rights: Withdrawal of Consent and Complaint to the Supervisory Authority

The data subject has the right at any time to request access to their personal data, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, the right to object to processing, and to exercise the right to data portability if the legal prerequisites exist. In any case, the data subject has the right to withdraw any consent previously given to data processing at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent given before its withdrawal. In case of alleged violation, the data subject, if the conditions are met, also has the right to lodge a complaint with a Data Protection Supervisory Authority in the EU member state of their habitual residence or where they work, or where the alleged violation occurred

8. Profiling and Automated Decision-Making Processes

Processing is not carried out through automated decision-making processes (e.g., profiling).

9. Contacts and Requests

To exercise the revocation of any consent given to the processing, exercise your rights (access, rectification, cancellation, limitation, opposition, portability) in relation to the data processing carried out, know and have more information also regarding the list and name of the external subjects to whom the data are communicated, the possible transfer of data to non-EU countries, the transfer mechanisms and protections.
